Rachel Meyer and Joshua Gerloff are co-owners of Epoch Preservation, a gravestone conservation business on the north shore of Massachusetts dedicated to the preservation of burying grounds and their artifacts, preserving stones in Gloucester, Salem, Saugus, Revere, Salisbury, Newbury, and Ipswich. In the summers they raise monarch butterflies saved from mowing paths in cemeteries.
